- Tuition is assessed on a per credit hour basis. The tuition rate for the 2023-24 academic year is \$710 per credit hour

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited U.S. college, university, or approved university outside the United States
- 3.0 GPA Preferred
- At least 3 years of work experience OR a minimum 3.2 undergraduate GPA and currently employed in the business field

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Online application
- Application essay
- Résumé or Curriculum Vitae
- Official transcripts from all post-secondary institutions
- Two letters of recommendation

ADDITIONAL INTERNATIONAL APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Proof of English proficiency (TOEFL or IELTS)
- WES/ECE evaluation of non-U.S. bachelor's degree
- Copy of picture page of passport
- Proof of financial support

DEADLINES

Applications are reviewed on a rolling basis. We recommend adhering to the following schedules, though application review and admission will continue beyond these dates as space permits:

- July 1st - Application deadline for fall semester (August)
- November 1st - Application deadline for spring semester (January)
