Capital University recognizes the Advanced Placement (AP) Examination Program of The College Board as an excellent way to earn university credit toward the baccalaureate degree. The following subject areas and minimum scores are accepted for university degree credit in the course areas and semester hours as indicated.

Art History

3 AP score Elective credit – History of Art (3 hours)
4-5 AP scores Art History 211 – Art History Survey I (3 hours)
and
Art History 212 – Art History Survey II (3 hours)

Art – Drawing

3-5 AP scores Elective credit – Art, Drawing (3 hours)
4-5 AP scores Art 121 – Drawing (4 hours)

Art – 2D Design

3 AP score Elective credit – Art, Design (3 hours)
4-5 AP scores Art 231– Design (4 hours)

Biology

3-5 AP scores Elective credit – Biology (3 hours)

Chemistry

3 AP score Elective credit – Chemistry (3 hours)
4-5 AP scores Chem 101 – Chemical Principles IA (4 hours)

Comparative Government/Politics

4-5 AP scores Elective credit – Comparative Government/Politics (3 hours)

Computer Science A

3 AP score Elective credit – Computer Science A (3 hours)
4-5 AP scores CS 160 – Introduction to Computer Science (3 hours)

Additional credit may be awarded with a score of 5 pending consultation with chair of mathematics/computer science/physics department.

Computer Science AB

3 AP score Elective credit – Computer Science B (3 hours)
4-5 AP scores CS 160 – Introduction to Computer Science (3 hours)

Additional credit may be awarded with a score of 5 pending consultation with chair of mathematics/computer science/physics department.

Economics – Micro

3-5 AP scores Economics 100 – Introduction to Political Economy (3 hours)***

Economics – Macro

3-5 AP scores Economics 100 – Introduction to Political Economy (3 hours)***

Note: If student receives a minimum score of 3 on both the micro and macro examinations, then 6 credit hours will be awarded for Economics 100 and Economics 200.
