Dear President Fredrickson:

This letter is to inform you of the results of the on-site evaluation of your teacher preparation programs conducted by the National Council for Accreditation of Teacher Education (NCATE) and the Ohio Department of Education (ODE). According to Section 3319.23 of the Ohio Revised Code, Ohio colleges and universities desiring to prepare educators must have and maintain both federal and state approval. Capital University has undergone the prescribed institutional on-site review by a team of NCATE examiners and has been apprised of all findings in the official NCATE Unit Accreditation Board (UAB) report.

Based on a review of the findings outlined in the UAB report, the Educator Standards Board recommended that Capital University receive an approval for seven years (continuing accreditation, next NCATE visit fall 2011). Based on this recommendation, Susan Tave Zelman, Superintendent of Public Instruction, has granted the recommended approval.
