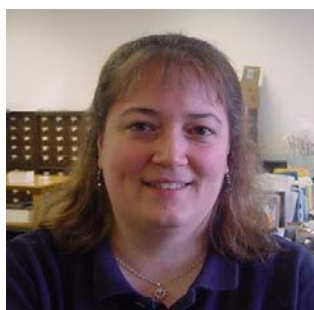

Crisis in Scholarly Communication

Relentlessly rising prices for scholarly journals are forcing academic libraries to drop subscriptions and to purchase fewer books. What can you do? For answers, see the brochure **“Create; New Systems of Scholarly Communication,”** to be distributed to faculty by the library.

What Resources are Blackmore Library Patrons Using?

Blackmore Library patrons were very busy researching in OhioLink databases. 20,288 articles were downloaded from 2086 unique journal titles in calendar year 2003. Ten or more downloads were made from 432 unique titles. The largest number of downloads 653, came from the journal **“The Arts in Psychotherapy”**. Rounding out the top ten downloaded titles are:

Additionally, our users performed 319 cluster searches, i.e. searches involving two or more databases at the same time. 94 **Electronic Books** were accessed. 2888 searches were conducted in 30 **OhioLink databases**. **Education Abstracts** was the favorite database for searching with 750 cumulative searches. **PsycINFO** was the second highest used database with 593 searches and **ERIC** was third with 453 searches.

About 46,000 searches were conducted in the 26 **EbscoHost** databases. Among the most heavily-used sources are: **Academic Search Premier** 13,256 searches; **Psychology and Behavioral Science Collection** 5763 searches; **Sociological Collection** 3790 searches; **Alternative Health Watch** 2630 searches; and **Health Source: Nursing/Academic Ed.** 582 searches.
