Proquest replaced by EBSCOHost Databases

On July 1, OhioLink replaced three Proquest databases: *Periodical Abstracts*, *Newspaper Abstracts*, and *ABI/Inform* databases with a database package from the vendor **EBSCO**. The benefits include more access to full-text documents and access to more scholarly journals. The EBSCO package of databases include:

Academic Search Premier: 3,460 full-text scholarly journals covering social sciences, humanities, engineering, education, computer science and ethnic studies.

Business Source Premier: 2,800 full-text scholarly journals covering management, economics, finance, accounting and including detailed company profiles

for the world's 5,000 largest companies.

Business Wire News: full-text news-wire database that incorporates business wires from around the world.

Newspaper Source: selected full-text for 225 newspapers including The Christian Science Monitor, Los Angeles Times, The Times (London), The Toronto Star, The Australian. Newswire coverage includes AP Online (Associated Press), Asia Pulse, Canadian Press Wire etc.

Health Source/Consumer Edition: access to 200 full-text periodicals, 1,200

pamphlets, 20 reference books 7,000 Clinical Reference Systems reports and Stedman's Medical dictionary.

Health Source/Nursing and Academic Edition: 580 full-text scholarly journals.

AltHealthWatch: full-text articles from more than 170 international newsletters, proceedings and reports on complementary, holistic health care and wellness.

Computer Source: 300 full-text journals.

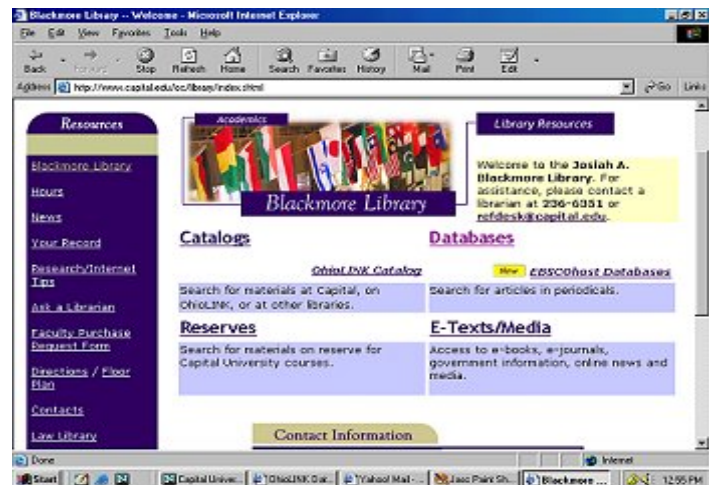
Psychology & Behavioral Science Collection: over 510 full-text titles covering psychiatry, psychology, anthropology, mental

Additional Databases

In our continuing effort to meet the needs of the Capital educational community, Blackmore Library has acquired additional databases. Besides those added through EBSCO (see above), the library has added the following databases to our reference collection:

- **Biography Resource Center:** 250 full-text periodicals and 60 biographical databases.
- **Books 24X7:** e-texts of business, finance, accounting, management, human resources, technology in business and marketing.
- **Economic Literature Index:** an update of the database Econlit.
- **E*Subscribe:** gives full-text access to the ERIC educational database.
- **Hoover's Online:** delivers continuously updated business info on public and private companies worldwide.
- **LexisNexis History:** now has access to African American Studies.
- **Marquis Who's Who:** an add-on to the Biography Resource Center database.
- **Social Studies Database:** 500 images of major archaeological sites from 1970-2000.
