

## Connecting Game Consoles to Capital University's Network

It is possible to connect your game console to Capital University's network. There are a couple of steps involved in order for you to enjoy either the Xbox Live experience or the PlayStation Network or getting the Wii online. Older game consoles can also be added but the information will not be included in this document.

Note: We can only add game consoles that have a ethernet cable that can be plugged into them. Yes I know the Wii comes with wireless built in but you are going to have to purchase the LAN adaptor if you want to use it on our network. Also the PlayStation 3 has wireless built in but you will have to use the network port, which comes conveniently built into the system.

In order for our system to recognize your game console we need to know the MAC (Media Access Control) Address of the console itself. We also need to know which room you will be staying in as well as contact information such as your name and phone number. The following steps will guide you in finding the MAC address for the Xbox 360, PlayStation 3 and Nintendo Wii.

### Xbox 360

1. Turn on the Xbox 360 and go to the Dashboard.
2. Go to the System blade.
3. Go to Network Settings.
4. Go to Edit Settings.
5. Go to the Additional Settings and select the Advanced Settings.
6. The MAC address is listed under where it says Wired MAC address.

### PlayStation 3

1. Turn on the PlayStation 3 without a disc in the system.
2. Go to Settings.
3. Go to Network Settings.
4. Go to Settings and Connection Status List.
5. The MAC address is listed under the section called MAC address.

### Nintendo Wii

1. Go to the Wii Settings menu.
2. Go to the Internet option.
3. Go to the Console Information section.
4. The MAC address will be listed under USB ethernet adaptor MAC address.
