Conservatory of Music Audition Application

We are pleased that you are applying for admission to Capital University. The instructions below are designed to aid you in your application to Capital University's Conservatory of Music. The requested information will assist us in making an admission decision based on your academic, musical and personal qualifications.

Prior to scheduling an audition, you must be academically admitted to the university.

To apply for admission to the university, please go to www.capital.edu/apply-now.

The purpose of the audition is to determine the musical qualifications of each student. **In addition to performing a prepared piece for audition, you also will be required to complete assessment testing.** You will be asked to complete a musicianship and audiation (theory) test to assist with placement in Conservatory Core classes.

Audition Days begin at 8:30 a.m., and last throughout the day. You should make plans to be on campus until late afternoon. Schedules are personalized, and will be distributed at registration. Family members are welcome to attend, but will not be permitted in the auditions. Programs have been designed to provide students and families with information about campus and Conservatory life, as well as the financial aid process. Campus tours will be offered, and lunch in the Capital Court is provided.

Within two to three weeks of your Audition Day, you will be notified of your audition results and scholarship award. Your audition performance, academic record and admission application information will be used to determine your scholarship availability.

A "live" audition always is preferred to a taped audition, especially for scholarship consideration. However, videotaped auditions may be accepted from applicants living outside the state of Ohio if travel to Columbus is impossible. Your submission must be a high-quality VHS or DVD and will not be returned. Applicants unable to meet these requirements should contact Heather Massey, coordinator of Conservatory Recruitment, at the address and numbers below.
