Conservatory Foundations

(15 hours)

The bachelor of arts degree in music requires a minimum of 124 completed hours for graduation. The following courses are required of all students working toward the bachelor of arts degree in music.

- Recital Attendance (each semester)
- Musicianship/Audiation I
- Musicianship/Audiation II
- Introduction to Music Software
- Music Literature I
- Music Literature II
- World Music Lab I-IV

Applied Music

Half Hour Private Lessons — required four semesters
Ensemble participation — required four semesters

Music Selectives

12-16 hours selected from any two of five music course groupings in the following areas: Theory, History, Technology, Performance, and Industry/Business

Student Electives

Music — 11 hours (any Conservatory Course)
Non-Music — 18 (any non-Conservatory University course)
