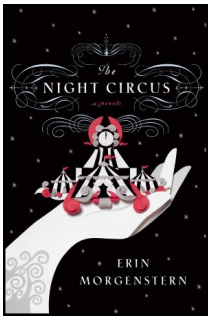

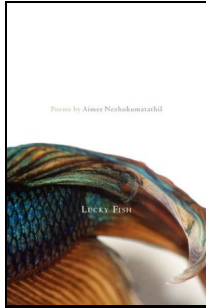
What is it? - A break from reading another chapter in your textbooks!

How Do I Participate?

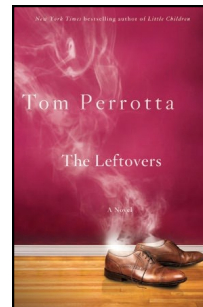
- **Select** a book from the five selections listed below

- **Complete** the entry form online by April 13th



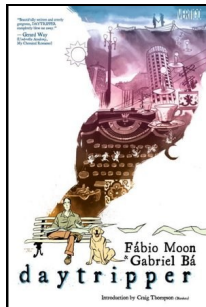

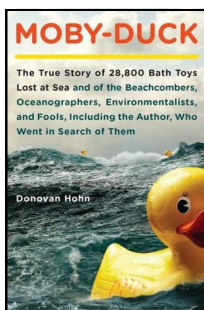
