The Capital City Teacher Residency (CCTR) is a fully online program that provides a unique pathway to earning a PK-5 Ohio or intervention specialist teaching license and potential bachelor's degree in education in as few as two years. Capital University's School of Education is partnering with Columbus City Schools and Columbus State Community College to offer an affordable and flexible option to earn licensure at Capital University, while working in a paid position in Columbus City Schools. All CCTR students will have access to dedicated support from Capital University faculty mentors, the flexibility to earn while learning, and the opportunity to earn a degree from a university with a long-standing reputation for excellence in education.

#### PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- Open to Columbus State Community College students and employees of Columbus City Schools district who have earned an associate's degree or higher. Some prerequisites are required.
- CCTR students is a two-year fully online program. Students work full-time with Columbus City Schools in a paid, full-time position during the day and complete coursework during non-working hours. Earn while you learn!
- Students in the CCTR program will graduate with PK-5 or Intervention Specialist licensure with the option to earn a bachelor's degree in education from Capital University.
- CCTR students with a bachelor's degree are eligible for adolescence to young adult licensures. The bachelor's degree must be in the content area of licensure.
- CCTR graduates commit to and are guaranteed a minimum three-year teaching position in Columbus City Schools.
