As a Capital University education licensure student, you can earn an Ohio teaching license in your choice of more than 15 specialties. Choose from:

Primary Childhood (grades Pre K-5)

Middle Childhood Education Generalist (grades 4-9)

- Mathematics
- English Language Arts

- Social Studies

Adolescence to Young Adult (grades 7-12)

- Integrated English Language Arts
- Integrated Mathematics
- Integrated Sciences
- Integrated Social Studies (History or Political Science focus)
