These courses are the core of our Master of Science in Nursing program and allow you to earn graduate credit while pursuing your BSN degree. TUITION AND FINANCIAL AID

- Tuition is assessed on a per credit hour basis. The tuition rate for the 2025–2026 academic year is \$664 per credit hour
- The approximate cost per semester (including tuition, fees, and books) is \$14,320, for a total annual cost of \$28,640*
- Through partnerships with Capital University, some tuition may be covered by credit waivers from your employer
- Federal financial aid is available to assist in financing your education
- Capital University accepts the GI bill and other veteran benefits

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited U.S. college, university, or approved university outside of the United States
- 2.75 cumulative GPA
- Prerequisite courses must be completed prior to acceptance and include: lifespan development (from birth to death), biochemistry†, microbiology†, human anatomy† and human physiology† (all systems)

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Online application for the Accelerated Bachelor of Science in Nursing
- Application essay
- Résumé or Curriculum Vitae
- Official transcripts from all post-secondary institutions
- Three letters of recommendation
- Interview with Program Associate Dean (at School of Nursing discretion)

DEADLINES

- Applications are reviewed on a rolling basis. Application review and admission may continue beyond deadlines as space permits
- December 1: Priority deadline
- May 1: Final deadline for application and all required forms
- Cohort begins each August

* Costs are estimates only and are subject to change due to course sequencing, annual fee increases, etc.

† Science prerequisites must have been taken within the last five years with a grade of C or better and must have had a lab component
