Great news, Cap Fam! We're excited to announce that we will be distributing sensory bags across campus.

What exactly is a sensory bag? For students with Autism, sensory bags are designed to help manage sensory overload, providing tools to self-regulate and feel more comfortable in various environments. The great thing about sensory bags, they can benefit anyone!

Our sensory bags will include:

- Sunglasses (to reduce the overwhelming impact of bright light, which can be triggering, and useful even indoors)
- Earplugs (to help reduce noise distractions)
- Fidget toys (which provide tactile stimulation and can help with focus)
- Soft sensory brushes (calming and stimulating for the senses)
- Candy (to offer a burst of sugar for energy or a calming effect for those who might feel overwhelmed).

Starting Monday, April 7, our ODI Interns will be distributing these sensory bags at the:

- Office of Diversity and Inclusion
- Office of Student and Community Engagement
- Office of Accessibility Services (Ruff Learning Center)
- Center for Health and Wellness (Kline Building).

We hope these bags provide comfort and support for our students, and we plan to keep them available all year long. A huge thank you to the Capital Autism Society for helping us bring this project to life. This is a true example of students serving students!


