- 2. The Thank You Letter can be emailed to finaid@capital.edu or you can drop the Thank You Letter off at Yochum Hall, 1st floor Financial Aid Office.
- 3. The letter template on page 2 may be copied and pasted directly to a word document.
- 4. Any place there is red on the template, enter information specific to you.
 - a. Examples are given for each instance.
- 5. There are two paragraphs highlighted in yellow. Choose whichever paragraph you would like to use and delete the other paragraph from your Thank You Letter.
- For extracurricular activities, enter any activities in which you participate on or off campus.
- 7. For the signature, you can print and physical sign your letter; you can sign with your Apple pen or you can use a script font.
- 8. Once complete,
 - a. Highlight your entire document and remove any highlighting, un-bold the text, ensure the text color is black.
 - b. Center your letter on the page.
 - c. Print or email and submit to the Financial Aid Office.
