

## CLEP Exam Recommendations

The College Level Examination Program (CLEP) is recognized by many colleges and universities throughout the United States. Beginning July 1, 2023, the new CLEP exam fee is \$93. In addition, designated CLEP testing centers charge an additional administrative fee (typically \$20-\$25) for each CLEP exam attempted; prospective test takers should contact the appropriate testing center for details. The College Board's *CLEP Official Study Guide* is a valuable resource of information about CLEP; test-takers may access CLEP information at <https://clep.collegeboard.org>. Minimum CLEP score and credit recommendations for Capital University appear below. Examination fees and/or credit recommendations are subject to change.

<sup>2</sup> A passing score on the Natural Sciences exam counts as 3 credits of elective credit. Students who earn a passing score on the CLEP Natural Sciences exam still have to take a Group C course to fully meet the General Education Natural Science Goal. A passing score on the CLEP Natural Sciences exam *cannot* be combined with a Group A or Group B course to meet the Natural Science General Education Goal.

<sup>3</sup> Financial Accounting is not available to students who have already earned equivalent credit for BUS 225.
