1. EDUC 310: Writing: Theory and Practice (3 credit hours)

This course focuses on the study of current theories in the reading and writing processes and their application to teaching writing for primarily 4-6 teachers. The course provides an overview of the six English Language Arts with a focus on reading and writing as they are found in Ohio's middle grade language arts classrooms. The fourteen online modules highlight Ohio Content Standards, NTCE Standards, and current best practice. Strategies for teaming are introduced and effective integration, especially of content reading and writing, is extended. Offered fall, spring, and summer.

2. EDUC 353: Math Pedagogy for Middle Childhood (2 credit hours)

This course prepares candidates to teach mathematics to students in middle grades. Candidates are prepared to use a body or resource material and technology and to plan lessons aligned with the ten Ohio Academic Content Standards for mathematics with appropriate assessments to meet the diverse needs of students. Strategies for teaming are introduced and effective integration of content is extended. Offered in the summer.

3. EDUC 354: Science Pedagogy for Middle Childhood (2 credit hours)

This course explores current best practice and theory for teaching grades 4-5. Emphasis will be placed on the life sciences. Students will design inquiry-based lessons using Ohio Academic Content Standards and the National Science Education Standards. Strategies for teaming are introduced and effective integration of content is extended. Offered in the summer.

4. EDUC 355: Social Studies Pedagogy for Middle Childhood (2 credit hours)

This course prepares candidates to teach social studies to the middle grades. Attention is paid to becoming better citizens and exploring global connections. The course prepares candidates to plan lessons with appropriate assessments that will stimulate students' development of social studies concepts and skills that are based on Ohio Content Standards and National Social Studies Standards. Strategies for teaming are introduced and effective integration of content is extended. Offered in the summer.
